Membership Categories

NAP membership is comprised of three membership categories

Distinguished Fellow

Distinguished Fellows require nomination by a colleague; application, review, and recommendation by the Academy of their profession; and approval by the Council.

Nominees are U.S. citizens who have an exemplary career of ten years or more and who have made significant contributions to interprofessional healthcare. Election as a Distinguished Fellow shall be for life, upon annual payment of membership dues.

Allowed use of the FNAP credentials.

May hold national and Academy offices and participate on committees.

Professional Members

Professional Members require nomination by self or colleague, application, review and recommendation by the Academy of their profession.

Nominees are U.S. citizens who have a career of five years or more, and are committed to interprofessional practice and accessible, affordable, healthcare for all.

May hold offices within Academy, except chair or vice chair, and participate in committees.

Associate Member

Associate membership does not require nomination, review, or approval.

Encouraged to participate in committees and attend the Annual Meeting & Forum.
